



# Snowball Wordbattle

Two players place the words E-L-F x 3, B-E-L-L x 2, H-O-L-L-Y x 1 and S-L-E-I-G-H x 1 on their own map. This is where their elf-family has hidden in the village. The youngest player begins by throwing a snowball at a number paired with a letter, 4C for example. If it hits a hidden letter the opponent tells what letter was hit. The first to hit all the letters of the opponents ELFS, BELLS, HOLLY and SLEIGH has won the snowball fight. You can try with other Christmas words your teacher wants you to learn.

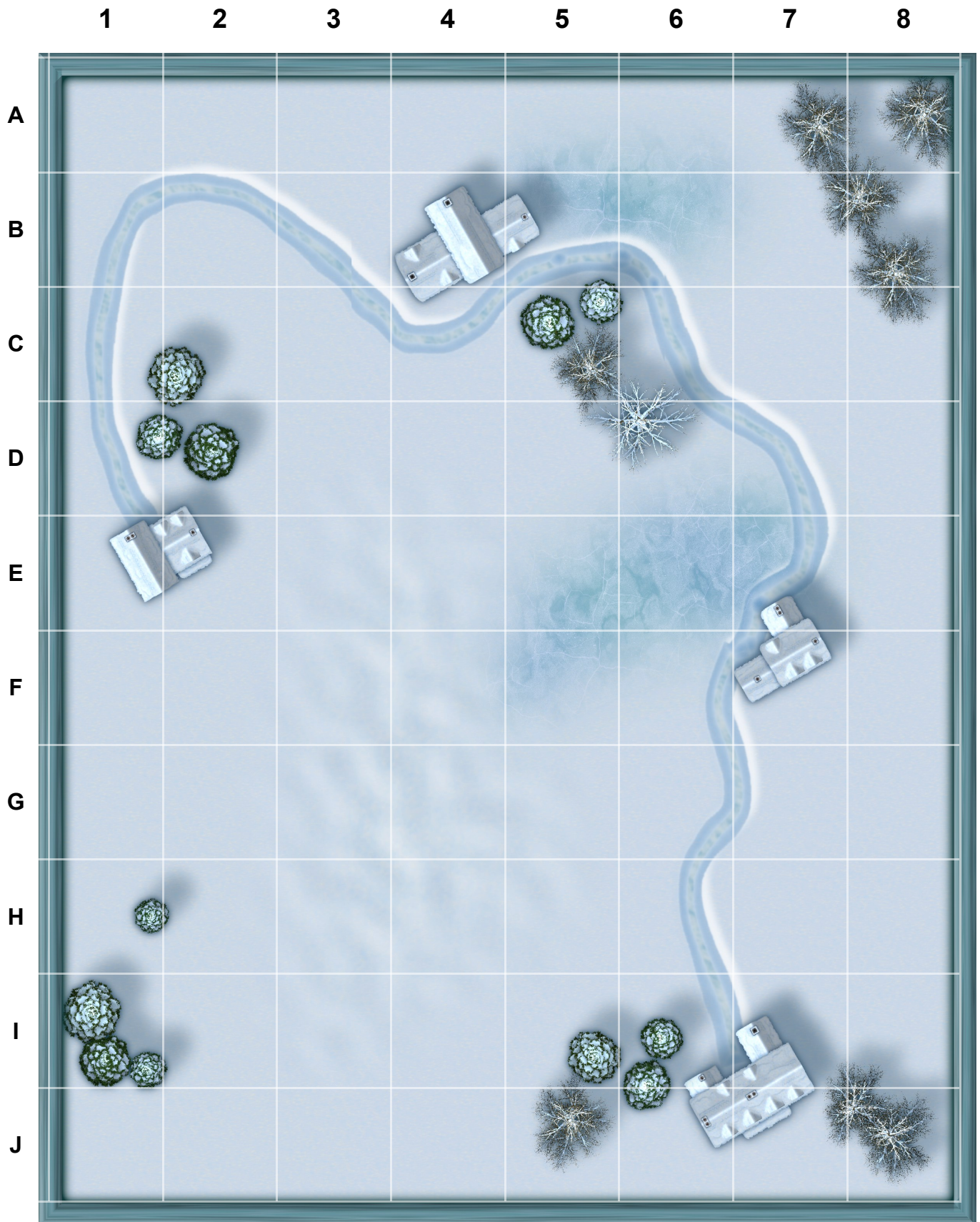
